Questions Read Daniel 10:1-21

How does Daniel's vision in the book of Daniel help us understand spiritual warfare?

Have you ever thought about there being angels for nations, churches, and people? Have you ever thought about there being demons for certain locations? What other questions does that bring up?

Considering Matthew 18:10, what does Jesus' statement about children's angels reveal about God's care for the vulnerable?

How can we maintain a balanced view of spiritual beings without falling into the extremes C.S. Lewis warned about?

In light of this sermon, how might you explain the concept of spiritual realities to someone who is skeptical about their existence?

How might understanding spiritual warfare affect your prayer life?

In light of the spiritual realities discussed in this sermon, how might you approach conflicts in your life differently?

Digging Deeper Rea Hebrews 1:1-4

Hebrews 1:1-2 contrasts God's communication "long ago" through the prophets with His speaking "in these last days" through His Son. How does this progression of divine revelation challenge our understanding of God's communication with humanity throughout history? How might this impact our approach to reading and interpreting different parts of Scripture?

In Hebrews 1:2-3, Christ is described as "the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being." How does this description of Jesus inform our understanding of the relationship between the Father and the Son in the Trinity?

Hebrews 1:3 states that Jesus is "sustaining all things by his powerful word." How does this ongoing role of Christ in the universe expand our understanding of His work beyond just creation and salvation? How might this truth influence our daily lives and our view of the natural world?
